

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1 Safety

DANGER

Failure to comply with the safety instructions in the «Safety Manual / System Manual» may result in serious injury or even death.

DANGER

Cuts from the saw blade.

- Always wear protective gloves when working on the wall saw, particularly when working on the saw blade.
- ▶ Always use the blade guard when operating the wall saw.



DANGER

Serious injury or material damage as a result of uncontrolled movements of the wall saw.


▶ Never connect or disconnect hoses while the drive unit is running.



- 6 Blade drive motor
- 7 Feed motor, swivel
- 8 Grip / lock unit
- 9 Chassis
- 10 Water line
- 11 Geared swivel arm
- 12 Guide roller

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
3 Assembly / disassembly

3.1 Place the wall saw on the guide rail




2. If the grips fail to engage or the wall saw sits too loosely on the guide rail: adjust the guide rollers.

3.2 Adjusting the guide rollers



* The guide rollers must sit in the guide groove, and it must be possible to turn them by hand.

3.4 Mount the saw blade



DANGER

It can cause death or serious injury if the saw blade flies away.

▶ Only use original screws and bolts from TYROLIT Hydrostress AG.



DANGER

Serious injury can be caused by sudden start-up of the saw blade.

- ► Switch off the drive unit before working on the saw blade.
- ► Depressurize the hoses.

3.4.1 Preparations for assembly

▶ During initial installation, remove the flush cut anchoring screws on the quick-release flange.


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3.4.2 Preassemble the saw blade unit




The direction of rotation of the saw blade must match the direction of rotation of the machine. Correct alignment: Countersinking of the fastening bores against the blade cover.


For normal cuts with saw blades up to Ø 1000 mm



For normal cuts with saw blades larger than Ø 1000 mm



For flush cuts




3.4.3 Fastening the saw blade unit



DANGER

It can cause death or serious injury if the saw blade flies away.

- ► Check whether the sleeve and central screw are countersunk.
- ▶ Tighten the central screw to a torque of 60 Nm.



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
3.5 Disassembling saw blade unit



WARNING


Injuries can be caused if the saw blade drops down.

▶ Lift out the saw blade unit to the top when removing it.



2. Disassemble the saw blade unit in the reverse order to the installation/assembly process.


3.6 Mount the blade guard



Mount the blade guard according to the instruction leaflet.

3.7 Connecting the wall saw to the drive unit

- ✓ The drive unit is isolated from the power supply.
- ✓ Couplings are clean.
- ✓ Hoses are undamaged.






4.2 Change gear oil




The use of unsuitable oil can damage the wall saw.

4.3 Replacing the guide rollers




▶ Defective guide rollers should be replaced with replacement set no. 10977911.
